Asset Management > Tables > Code Tables > Status Code

This tab is used to create the Status Code table. You can enter status codes and descriptions for managing assets in the system. This is a user-defined table, so you may use any codes/descriptions. The codes should indicate the status of the items.

Examples:

A - Actively Used Item
I - Inactive Item
O - Out of Warranty
R - Returned to Manufacturer
S - Salvaged

Note: A specific code must be added for deleting items under Utilities (e.g., To Be Deleted).

Set up a status code:

Click **+Add** to add a row.

Field	Description
Status Code	Type a user-defined, one-character alpha or numeric code (e.g., 1, 2, 3, A, B, C).
Status Description	Type a user-defined description of the status code (e.g., Active, Disposed, New, Inactive). The field can be a maximum of 40 characters.

Click **Save**.

Other functions and features:

Retrieve	Retrieve data. The Retrieve button is also used to retrieve information from the last save. If you click Retrieve , any unsaved changes are lost.

Print	<p>Print code data.</p> <p>Click to print data. The following Asset Management Code Table options are displayed:</p> <p>Current Tab Page - prints only the tab page currently open.</p> <p>Selected Code Tables - displays the following options from which you can select:</p> <p>Catalog</p> <p>Status Code</p> <p>Insurance Code</p> <p>Gain Code</p> <p>Condition Code</p> <p>Property Class Code</p> <p>All Code Tables - prints all the code tab pages.</p> <p>Select an option and click OK to view a copy of the report. Otherwise, click Cancel to return to the tab.</p> <p>Review the report.</p>
	<p>Delete a row.</p> <p>Click to delete a row. The row is shaded red to indicate that it will be deleted when the record is saved.</p> <p>Click Save.</p>
