This report provides a list of the budget accounts and balances by major object code. Revenue and expenditure categories spanning various accounting periods can be printed as required by TEC SEC 39.0822.

| Parameter   | Parameter Description  |
|---|--|
| <b>From Accounting Period</b>                             | Type the two-digit from accounting period. This is a required field.   |
| <b>To Accounting Period</b>                               | Type the two-digit to accounting period. This is a required field.   |
| <b>Select Fund(s), or blank for ALL</b>                   | Type the three-digit fund number separating multiple fund numbers with a comma (e.g., 161 / 8,199 / 8). Or, click  to search for funds/years. Otherwise, leave blank to use all fund numbers. |
| <b>Include Object Code 5XXX (R), 6XXX (E) or Both (B)</b> | R - Include object code 5XXX accounts on the report.<br>E - Include object code 6XXX accounts on the report.<br>B - Include both 5XXX and 6XXX accounts on the report.<br>This is a required field.  |
| <b>Include Object Code 15XX (Y,N)</b>                     | Y - Include object code 15XX accounts on the report.<br>N - Do not include object code 15XX accounts on the report.<br>This is a required field.   |
| <b>Subtotal by (F) Fund, (T) Fund Type or (N) None</b>    | F - Include subtotals by fund on the report.<br>T - Include subtotals by fund type on the report.<br>N - Do not include subtotals by fund or fund type on the report.<br>This is a required field.   |
| <b>Enter Optional Report Title</b>                        | Type a report title using a maximum of 60 alphanumeric characters.   |
