#### **Navigating within CareerPortal**

CareerPortal makes it easy to get around.

## **Searching within CareerPortal**

CareerPortal provides many ways to search for information. These include:

Field	Description
Search	Dynamically search all columns based on input typed into the field.
Grid Sort	Sort columns at any time by clicking on a column's heading. Click the heading once to sort the grid information in ascending order. Click the heading again to sort the grid information in descending order.
<b>Grid Search</b>	Dynamically search a column based on input typed into the field.

## **Searching CareerPortal jobs**

Searching jobs on CareerPortal is facilitated in two ways.

- Click Job Search on the CareerPortal home page.
- Log in to your CareerPortal account, and click Search Jobs in your CareerPortal account sidebar.

Full screen mode

CareerPortal provides a full screen mode for easy viewing and searching. To enter full screen mode:

Click your username in the top right corner. A drop-down menu will appear.

Click Full Screen.

Press ESC to exit full screen mode.
