



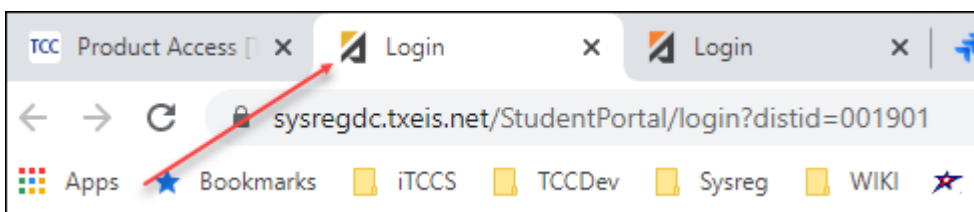

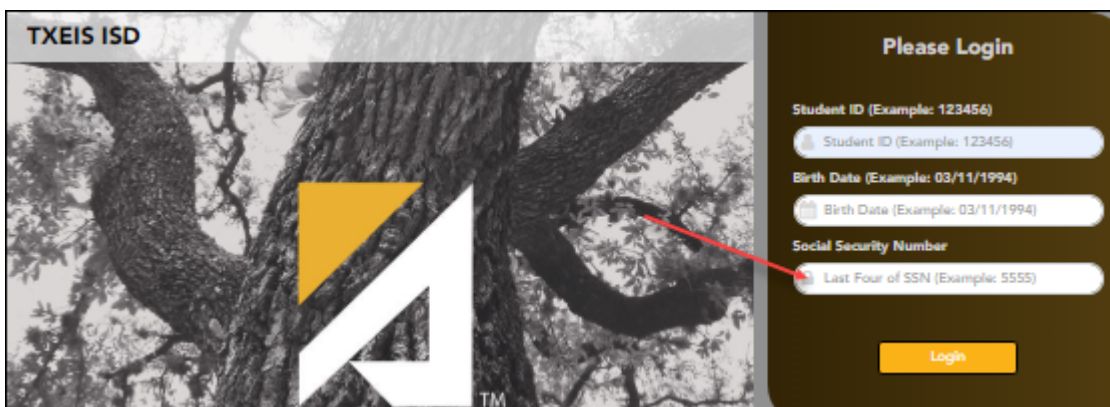
## UAT Updates

- ☐ Updated the favicon for StudentPortal.



## Login

- ☐ Renamed the text in the **Social Security Number** field to indicate that students should enter the last four digits of their Social Security Number.



- ☐ Corrected the issue that caused a blank page to be displayed when a student logged on to StudentPortal after moving Graduation Plan courses into Scheduling.

## StudentPortal > Attendance

- ☐ Modified the Attendance pages to mirror the functionality of the ParentPortal attendance pages.

## StudentPortal > Attendance > Detailed View

- ☐ Corrected the program to display attendance data for active courses only for transfer students.

## StudentPortal > Grades > Cycle & Semester Grades > Cycle Grades

- ☐ Added the ability to view Cycle Grade Details for the previous semester.
- ☐ Corrected the Cycle Grade Details to display the **Possible Points** for each assignment grade and category for courses that used points-based grading.

## StudentPortal > Course Request

- ☐ Corrected the program to display courses that were previously excluded (i.e., **Excl Stu Crs Req** selected on **Scheduling > Maintenance > Master Schedule > Campus > Courses**) but are no longer excluded.
- ☐ Added spacing between the **Previous/Next Subject** buttons and the **Submit** button, and also modified the button colors, to help prevent users from unintentionally clicking **Submit**.
