# Options (MSALGO)

## **Scheduling > Maintenance > MSALGO > Process > Options**

This tab displays scheduling options populated by the [Master Schedule Algorithm \(MSALGO\) Export](#). MSALGO fields are also displayed. These options must be verified or set as default values before continuing with the process.

### **Update settings:**

**NOTE:** The MSALGO Export must be run before this page is available. If the export was not run previously, a message is displayed indicating that MSALGO options are not available. Run the export, then return.

Enter the following:

|                       |   |
|-----------------------|---|
| <b>First Period</b>   | Select the first class period of the day that can be scheduled.   |
| <b>Nbr Periods</b>    | Select the number of periods per day for which courses are offered. Valid periods for the day are from <b>First Period</b> through <b>(Nbr Periods + First Period) - 1</b> .  |
|                       | <b>Examples:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If <b>First Period</b> is 00 and <b>Nbr Periods</b> is 8, the valid periods are 00-07.</li> <li>• If <b>First Period</b> is 01 and <b>Nbr Periods</b> is 8, the valid periods are 01-08.</li> </ul> |
| <b>Low Grd Level</b>  | Select the lowest and highest grade levels that can be scheduled at the campus.   |
| <b>High Grd Level</b> | These field allow to you to indicate that the campus is adding grade levels for the next school year.   |
| <b>Nbr of Sem</b>     | Select the number of semesters to be scheduled at the campus in the next school year.   |

Click **Save**.
