

The following special characters are allowed: +, -, *, &lt;, &gt;, @, &amp;, #, /, and \.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Click <b>Add</b> (under the <b>Enter Grades</b> fields) to add the grade type to the <b>Grade Type</b> grid. The new grade type is listed under <b>Name</b>.</p>									
	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Click <b>Save</b>.</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> In the <b>Grade Type</b> grid, delete a grade type if needed.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> You cannot delete or edit a grade type that is associated with a report card; the <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> button is not displayed.</p>									



	<p>In the <b>Available Skill Sets</b> grid, delete a skill set if needed. Some skill sets are included automatically and cannot be deleted. They are shaded gray and the  button is not displayed. However, you can click  to add additional skills to the predefined list.</p> <p>The following skill sets are included automatically:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Numbers</li> <li>• Letters</li> <li>• Letters (including Spanish)</li> <li>• High-Frequency Word List</li> <li>• Color Word Recognition</li> <li>• Rote Counting</li> </ul>

<b>Description</b>	Type a description of the skill as you want it to be displayed on the report card, up to 300 characters. This description is also displayed for the teacher on the Assignment Grades page when hovering the cursor over the skill name.
	From the <b>Available Skills for Skill Set</b> grid, delete a skill from the skill set if needed. Some skill sets have skills that are included by default and cannot be deleted.
