## **Export by File ID - BAM7400**

#### Asset Management > Utilities > Export by File ID

This utility is used to copy the selected file IDs to a user-designated archive file. If exporting the current or prior file ID (i.e., file ID C or 3), all Asset Management tables are exported.

#### **Export file IDs:**

A list of all available file IDs is displayed on the left side of the page under <b>Available File IDs</b> .
☐ Select the desired file IDs to be exported.
$\square$ Use the following buttons to move the selected file IDs to the right side of the page.
- Click to move selected entries from the left side to the right side of the page.  - Click to move all entries from the left side to the right side of the page.  - Click to move selected entries from the right side to the left side of the page.  - Click to move all entries from the right side to the left side of the page.
☐ Click <b>Execute</b> to execute the process. A message is displayed indicating that you are about to export Asset Management tables and confirming that you want to continue.
<ul> <li>Click <b>Yes</b> to continue the export.</li> <li>Otherwise, click <b>No</b> to cancel the export.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>In the Enter a Password for the Archive field, type a password for the exported file and click OK.</li> </ul>

The Save As dialog box is displayed.

• Otherwise, click Cancel.

• In the **File name** field, the file name is set to dbcccddd\_mmddyyyy\_bam.rsf, where cccddd is the county-district number, X is the file ID, and mmddyyyy is the current date. You can type a different name for the file. Navigate to the appropriate folder and save the file.

A message is displayed indicating that the export process completed successfully. Click **OK**.
