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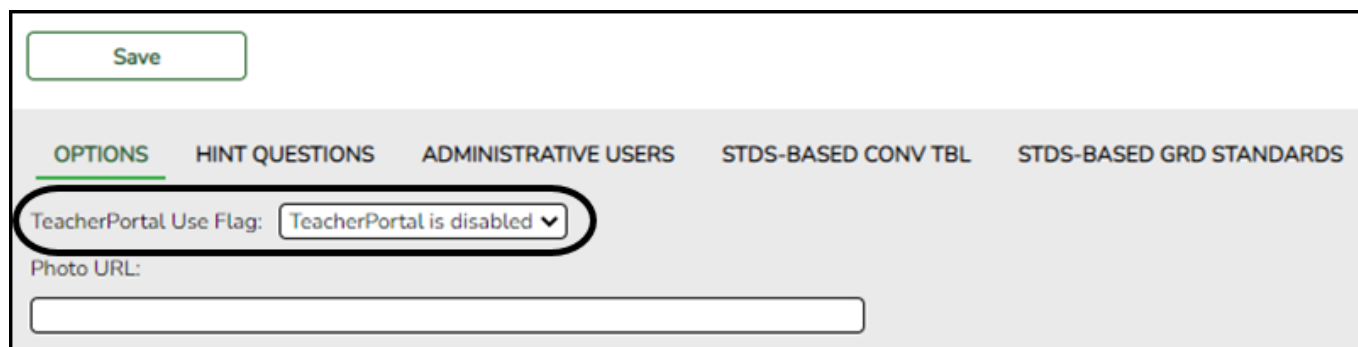
Disable Portals

NOTE: The following are district-level settings that affect all campuses.
