



Receiving Campus (Reverse Scheduling Transfer)

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Registration > Utilities > Reverse Scheduling Transfer > Receiving Campus

Use this utility if you are logged on as the receiving campus.

This utility reverses a scheduling transfer.

At the sending campus, all records with record status code 3 (*currently enrolled at this campus, will attend new campus next year*) are reset to record status code 1 (*currently enrolled at this campus*).

At the receiving campus, all records with record status code 4 (*enrolled at another campus, will attend this campus next year*) are deleted.

A reverse scheduling transfer can be performed by either the sending campus or the receiving campus. If you are logged on as the receiving campus, use the [Reverse Scheduling Transfer > Sending Campus](#) utility.
