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
Some districts may update data in TSDS tables from a text flat file created outside TxEIS where each row in the file corresponds to a TSDS record.

The only TSDS record types available for importing are:

- Organization-District (010)
- Organization-Campus (020)
- Finance-Budget (030)
- Finance-Actual (032) **(not used for Fall)**
- Finance-SSA Actual (033) **(not used for Fall)**

**IMPORTANT!** Only these record types can be imported. **All other records are skipped.**



**File** Click **Browse** to select the file to import.

	Click <a href="#">First</a> to go to the first page of the report. Click <a href="#">◀</a> to go back one page. Click <a href="#">▶</a> to go forward one page. Click <a href="#">Last</a> to go to the last page of the report.															
	<b>The report can be viewed and saved in various file formats.</b>															
	Click  to save and print the report in PDF format. Click  to save and print the report in CSV format. (This option is not available for all reports.) When a report is exported to the CSV format, the report headers may not be included. Click  to close the report window. Some reports may have a <b>Close Report</b> , <b>Exit</b> , or <b>Cancel</b> button instead.															
	Records that resulted in an error are listed. The line number in the file corresponding to the record that caused an error is displayed in the first column, and the record itself is displayed in the second column. A summary of the import is printed on the last page of the report.
